



Making Stained Glass Windows

1. Look at the example of stained glass windows on page 61 of your textbook.
2. Gather crayons, waxed paper, construction paper, and scissors.
3. Draw your picture on a piece of waxed paper.
4. When you have finished drawing, place another piece of waxed paper on top on the drawing and iron.

(Be sure the iron is not on a "hot" setting.)

5. With construction paper, make a frame for the window.

If possible, hang your stained glass window in a window so that the sunlight can shine through.
