



## Visiting the Reconciliation Chapel

1. Make arrangements in advance to bring your group to the reconciliation chapel.
2. Explain to the children that at Reconciliation services, there are often many stations set-up around the church for people to go to the priest for absolution.
3. Tell the children that individual reconciliation is available at particular times each week. The reconciliation chapel is used for individual reconciliation.
4. Provide an opportunity for a few children at a time to go into the chapel.
5. Point out that people have a choice. They can sit so they are facing the priest. Or, they can sit so that the priest cannot see who they are.
6. Emphasize that reconciliation focuses on God's forgiveness and our wanting to do better.
