



You + Me = Us

Materials needed: Washable tempera paint on sponges (to be used as an ink pad), drawing paper, crayons and some real (or artificial) flowers

1. Pass the flowers around so that children can see that each petal is not exactly the same as another, but that all the petals together make a beautiful flower.
2. Instruct the children to make flowers using their thumbprints for the flower petals.

Encourage the children to gather each other's thumbprints for their flowers.
